Subject: Washington Bridge Snapshot Report

Legislation passed on May 2, 2024, page 3, item (d) states that “Upon receipt of information reflecting an unexpected change in the anticipated progress in repairing or replacing the Washington Bridge, the department shall promptly transmit the information to the governor, the president of the senate and the speaker of the house rather than delay until the next snapshot report due date.” Therefore, the department offers the following update:

The demolition of the Washington Bridge No. 700 was paused on September 17, 2024, prior to the start of overnight demolition. The pause is required to collect evidence to support the state’s litigation. Demolition work is expected to resume within the next several days.
