RE: H 7431 An Act Relating to Public Utilities and Carriers - Net Metering

Dear Chairman Solomon,

Thank you for providing the Department of Environmental Management (DEM) the opportunity to comment on H 7431, which would make technical corrections to a renewable energy siting law enacted in 2023. DEM supports this legislation.

H 7431 would correct a drafting error included in legislation enacted last year which limits access to the state's renewable energy incentive programs for projects located in core forests. Specifically, the law currently includes a definition of the term "core forest" which references forests located "at least twenty-five (25) <u>acres</u> from mapped roads..." when it should refer to twenty-five <u>yards</u>. This correction will ensure that DEM, in partnership with the Office of Energy Resources and Rhode Island Energy, can smoothly implement the requirements in the law.
