Please accept this letter of opposition to proposed House Bill #7082, which imposes an unreasonable and damaging medical loss ratio on dental insurers. I'm very concerned about the serious detrimental consequences associated with this Bill, especially in relation to escalating premium costs and rising out of pocket expenses for dental care that will impact all dentally insured Rhode Islanders going forward.

In my experience, dental insurance premiums have remained stable, access to care has been excellent and all members of my family have been beneficiaries of outstanding coverage. Passage of this Bill puts the excellent oral healthcare programs offered through commercial insurers to Rhode Island employers and their employees in jeopardy.
