On behalf of the over 10,000 members of the Laborers' International Union of North America (LIUNA) in Rhode Island, I write in SUPPORT of H 5576 Utility Thermal Energy Network and Jobs Act. This legislation invests in renewable thermal energy networks, a clean, efficient, alternative energy source to significantly reduce emissions without adding stress to our power grid. Geothermal energy can provide reliable energy directly from the ground. Our union strongly supports an all-of-the-above approach to energy availability and reliability, and there is great potential for geothermal to fit into this mix.

Critically, this bill protects and supports workers, who we currently represent in the fossil fuel industry, by ensuring we can apply our existing skills to jobs in the renewable energy sector. It promotes a level playing field, the potential for project labor agreements, and opens pathways to family-supporting careers through registered apprenticeship and training programs.
