Senate Bill No. 2529 allows us to continue shaping our early childhood programs in alignment with the standards found in the Bright Stars Rating System with the flexibility to adapt them to the particular program and structure of Bay View. Further, it eliminates the financial impact that we would have to bear to participate in the Bright Stars assessment that would jeopardize the viability of a program of our size.

We deeply appreciate that Senate Bill No.2529 maintains the optional nature of the Bright Stars Rating system for private schools while maintaining everyone's access to the resources and standards as needed. We believe this strikes the balance needed for small private programs.
