RE: H 8043 An Act Relating to State Affairs and Government – State Agency Emission Reporting

Dear Chairman Bennett,

Thank you for providing the Department of Environmental Management (DEM) the opportunity to comment on H 8043, which would require the Executive Climate Change Coordinating Council (EC4) to develop a template that can be used by all state agencies to track their climate emissions. DEM supports this legislation.

State agencies like DEM play a key role in helping to reduce greenhouse gas emissions from vehicles, buildings, and energy usage. As a large energy user, DEM must do its part to adopt cost-effective energy efficiency measures, renewable energy resources, and more sustainable heating and transportation solutions. As we take steps to reduce greenhouse gas emissions, it is appropriate that state agencies are also asked to do the same and the development of a template will aid agencies as they track their emissions.
