RE: Bill Number: 7999 AN ACT RELATING TO STATE AFFAIRS AND GOVERNMENT -- THE RHODE ISLAND MUNICIPAL INFRASTRUCTURE GRANT PROGRAM

Dear Chairman Abney and Honorable Members of the House Finance Committee:

I am writing to express our support for House Bill 7999, which proposes to reallocate the \$5.5 million appropriation from the 2023 budget act to the Municipal Infrastructure Grant Program. This initiative, championed by the Rhode Island League of Cities and Towns, is vital for advancing crucial municipal infrastructure projects across our state.

The decision to transfer these funds from the Municipal Matching Grant Pool program to the Municipal Infrastructure Grant Program is both strategic and timely. The lack of requests for this funding, coupled with the challenges communities face in meeting federal and state requirements, underscores the need for a more effective allocation of resources.

By reallocating these funds, we can bolster investments that directly benefit our communities, fostering growth and development in areas identified as key for future expansion and redevelopment.

Our members have directly benefited from the Municipal Infrastructure Grant Program, utilizing funds to undertake critical infrastructure projects that enhance the quality of life for Rhode Island residents. This reallocation of resources will not only stimulate job creation and economic growth but also address pressing needs in housing and community development.

Therefore, we urge your support for House Bill 7999 to help ensure the \$5.5 million appropriation is allocated to eligible municipal infrastructure grant projects. This legislation aligns with our shared goals of advancing sustainable development and improving the well-being of our 39 cities and towns.
