

- Established by State Constitution as one of the five general offices
 - Fulfills the executive responsibilities of the Governor upon death, resignation, impeachment or inability to serve
- Serves as Chairperson of:
 - Small Business Advocacy Council
 - Emergency Management Advisory
 Committee
 - Long-Term Care Coordinating Council

FY 2026 Summary By Category



Salaries and Benefits

- \$1.3 million and 8 FTE for FY 2026
 - \$65,983 more than enacted for FY 2025
 - Staff title revisions
 - Statewide adjustments, including COLA
 - Updated projections to fund interns
 - Seasonal Policy Interns
 - Pursue federal funding for Long-Term Care Coordinating Council
 - Assist with other Office initiatives
 - Housing, healthcare, veterans, older adults
 - \$41,600 annually to fund positions
