Last year the Governor signed into law The Individual Health Care Coverage Act which codified into RI law important essential health care benefits guaranteed by the federal Affordable Health Care Act, but which had been threatened by Congressional members attempting to dismantle the ACA. While that act helps to protect individuals from expensive medical costs, there are still barriers to accessing care long-term and threats to individuals' financial security. The bill before you today which according to the bill summary "would repeal the authority of the health insurance commissioner to enforce any act of the United States Congress or a federal court decision that invalidates or repeals the prohibition of annual and lifetime limits on health insurance contained in the federal Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act as it pertains to this state" would provide important additional protection, such as helping to reduce the prospects of bankruptcy in certain cases.

I share the views of the League of Women Voters of RI, of which I'm a member, and the Coalition for Reproductive Freedom in urging you to pass this Important piece of legislation.
