RE: H 8237 -- An Act Relating to Businesses and Professions - Nurse Anesthetists

Dear Chair Donovan:

Please accept this letter regarding H 8237. This legislation would establish that the administration of drugs classified by the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) as general anesthetics (including propofol and ketamine) for minimal, moderate, deep sedation, or general anesthesia is not, generally, within the "scope of practice" of registered nurses and advanced practice registered nurses (other than licensed certified registered nurse anesthetists (CRNAs)) as defined in R.I. Gen. Laws § 5-34-3. The act would restrict the administration of anesthesia medications to licensed CRNAs, with certain exceptions, and would take effect upon passage.

Please know the Rhode Island Department of Health (RIDOH) has received correspondence from the Rhode Island Association of Nurse Anesthetists regarding the administration of general anesthetics by non-CRNAs. RIDOH is in the process of reviewing current statutory and regulatory requirements as well as the latest clinical guidance regarding this practice. RIDOH has met with various professional boards and groups and has reached out to national clinical subject matter experts to consult with RIDOH on the merits and safety of this practice.

I look forward to working with the Committee, key stakeholders, and clinical subject matter experts during this review to suggest any legislative and/or regulatory changes that may be needed to protect patient health and safety and align with current clinical guidance and best practices.
