On behalf of the members and board members of Defenders of Animals, Inc., I am respectfully requesting that you vote in favor of House Bill No. 7075 By Edwards, Diaz, Bennett, Serpa, Potter, and Chippendale that would provide that the trapping and subsequent release of any unowned feral or free roaming cat for the purpose of spaying or neutering of the cat would not be considered abandonment.

Organizations and individuals are spending enormous amounts of time and money keeping the feral cat population down, making sure that feral cats have been inoculated to prevent rabies, and neutered to keep the population in check.
