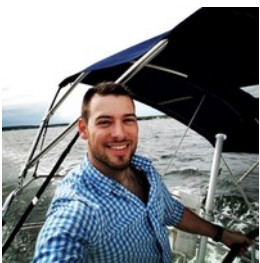
I urge the committee to reject HB-5436 and focus on enforcing existing laws rather than placing undue burdens on law-abiding gun owners.
