## re: support of H5436, H5651, 5652

Dear Chairman Craven and Committee Members:

The spiritual call to love is a call to non-violence. It is the recognition that not only are we co-creators with the Divine, but that we are deeply and intimately connected to one another.

Early Christian reflection on violence provided a clear alternative to the dominating power of the Roman State. Jesus instructed his followers to pray for their enemies, to include those who had been cast aside, and to recognize our responsibility to respond to fear with love.

We are inextricably bound together in a common humanity, and in our daily work to live lives of faith, we recognize the essential need to advocate for laws that are just and that also disrupt cycles of violence.

Banning assault style weapons and implementing common sense restrictions for individuals who have a history of violence speaks to our moral, spiritual, and civic responsibility to care for one another.
