I am writing in support of H 7171. I believe that expanding paid family leave is extremely important. I am a single parent to a now 6 year old boy and work full time as a clinical child psychologist at Hasbro Children's Hospital. When I had my son, it was both an incredibly happy time and a miracle for me but also an extremely anxiety provoking and stressful time. Maternity leave is hard. Breast feeding for me was impossible. Recovering from a C-section was painful and difficult. Navigating parenthood and adjusting to this major life change was extremely challenging, and I was lucky to have very close family around to help. The reality that my full leave was not paid was an added stressor, especially as a single parent with no other income. I personally was lucky to have family support, but I can't even imagine how others in different situations can manage. I took 4 months of maternity leave, which still wasn't enough time as just when things are finally settling, it's time to transition back to work. However, I'm forever grateful that I had that time to care for both my child's needs and my own and couldn't imagine being in a position to have to return to work after a fraction of that time because of financial needs. I believe that extended family leave is incredibly important so that people can be in better positions to continue in their jobs knowing that their family's needs are being addressed.
