RESOLUTION #2024-02

RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY TO ENACT LEGISLATION RELATING TO THE ISSUANCE OF BONDS AND/OR NOTES IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$ 10,700,000 TO FINANCE THE RENOVATION AND/OR EXPANSION AT THE EXISTING GLOCESTER POLICE STATION AND INCIDENTAL FURNISHINGS AND EQUIPMENT TO BE APPROVED AT REFERENDUM TO BE HELD ON NOVEMBER 5, 2024 OR SUCH EARLIER DATE AS SELECTED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL

The Town Council of the Town of Glocester hereby resolves as follows:

WHEREAS, the Town is in need of renovation and additional space for police and emergency operations and related equipment to adequately perform its functions for the citizens of the Town of Glocester ("Town"); and

WHEREAS, the Town Council has determined that such need can be best addressed with the renovation and/or expansion of the existing police station on Chopmist Hill Road (the "Project");

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Town Council of the Town of Glocester hereby requests the General Assembly to enact legislation to authorize the Town to issue general obligation bonds and/or notes in an amount not to exceed \$ 10,700,000 to finance the renovation and/or expansion at the Glocester Police Station, on Chopmist Hill Road, including incidental furnishings and equipment and costs of issuance, substantially in the form presented to the Town Council with such changes as the Town Solicitor or bond counsel may deem necessary or appropriate, such legislation and bond issuance to be subject to voter approval at a referendum to be held on November 5, 2024 or such earlier date as may be determined by the Town Council.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Taft & McSally LLP is hereby engaged as bond counsel to the Town.
