

RESOLUTION:

TO THE HONORABLE RI GENERAL ASSEMBLY REQUESTING
AN AMENDMENT TO RIGL § 44-3-3
TO EXEMPT THE PROPERTY OF THE FRIENDS OF LITTLE COMPTON
WELLNESS CENTER, INC.
FROM TAXATION

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF LITTLE COMPTON AS FOLLOWS:

WHEREAS: RIGL § 44-3-3 exempts the real and personal property of certain non-profit corporations; and

WHEREAS: The Friends of Little Compton Wellness Center, Inc. is a non-profit corporation, originally incorporated on June 6, 1996; and

WHEREAS: The Friends of Little Compton Wellness Center, Inc. engages in charitable and other activities such as promoting healthy living through programs that focus on exercise, well-being, brain health and social activities that benefit the citizens of the Town of Little Compton; and

WHEREAS: The Friends of Little Compton Wellness Center, Inc. activities warrant an exemption of its real and personal property.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF LITTLE COMPTON AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: That the Town Council of the Town of Little Compton requests that the Honorable General Assembly amend RIGL § 44-3-3 to include the real and personal property of the Friends of Little Compton Wellness Center, Inc. as exempt from taxation.

SECTION 2: That this resolution shall be forwarded to the members of the Town of Little Compton's General Assembly delegation, as well as the Speaker of the House of Representatives and the President of the Senate upon passage by the Little Compton Town Council.

SECTION 3: THAT THIS RESOLUTION SHALL BECOME EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY UPON ITS PASSAGE BY THE LITTLE COMPTON TOWN COUNCIL.
