Testimony in Support of H5450: All-Electric Building Act

To: Chair Casey and the honorable Members of the Municipal Government and Housing Committee,

I am writing to express my strong support for H5450, the All-Electric Building Act.

As someone who's worked in the building industry for over 8 years, I've seen firsthand the tendency for architects and builders to design and build to the lowest acceptable standard. If we didn't have fire codes, we would have a lot more devastating building fires. If we didn't have structural codes, we would have a lot more catastrophic building collapses. It's time to protect people and the environment by raising our standards for the fuel we use to power our lives. It's time for all-electric buildings.

All-electric buildings provide strong economic, environmental, and health benefits, including:

- Reducing carbon emissions, which is essential for meeting our currently not-ontrack Act on Climate goals in Rhode Island.
- Reducing infrastructure costs, since gas mains, services, and meters can be avoided.
- Reducing system costs by reducing the need for separate heating and cooling systems.
- **Improving indoor air quality** by eliminating the pollutants coming from natural gas ranges (including nitrogen dioxide, carbon monoxide, and formaldehyde).
- Increasing thermal comfort by providing more stable temperatures indoors through better technology.
- Increasing independence from fossil fuel companies, who have systematically lobbied against the interests of the environment and the public.
- Increasing stability and resilience through reliance on regenerative energy sources.

The choice is clear: we need all-electric buildings now.
