Thank you for providing the Department of Environmental Management (DEM) the opportunity to comment on H 7246, which would require the state's economic development policy and vision to consider climate change, sea-level rise, and coastal resiliency. It would also add the directors of DEM and the Coastal Resources Management Council to the state's economic development planning council. DEM supports this legislation.

The impacts of climate change are already being experienced by Rhode Island, from more severe storms to higher temperatures and higher sea levels.
