I support House Bill 5193 because it enhances safety for first responders and the community by ensuring clear identification of residences where electric and hybrid vehicles powered by lithium-ion batteries are stored. By implementing identification stickers on residences and maintaining a registry of these vehicles, emergency personnel can quickly assess potential hazards and respond more effectively in the event of a fire or other emergencies.
