RE: BILL NUMBER H-5514 - AN ACT RELATING TO ELECTIONS -- MAIL BALLOTS

Chair Shanley and Honorable Committee Members,

On behalf of the Rhode Island League of Cities and Towns, I write to express our support for House Bill 5514, which would exempt emergency mail ballots from the requirement to include certain wording regarding "mail voters" on the ballot.

This legislation represents an important step in streamlining the election process for municipalities and ensuring that emergency mail ballots remain accessible and efficient for voters in need. The existing requirement for specific wording on these ballots has created administrative challenges that can delay processing and add unnecessary complexity for local election officials. By removing this requirement, H-5514 would allow municipalities to better serve voters while maintaining the integrity and security of the election process.

Additionally, this bill aligns with the broader goal of modernizing Rhode Island's election procedures by reducing bureaucratic hurdles that do not enhance election security but instead create inefficiencies at the local level. Our cities and towns strive to provide clear, reliable, and accessible voting options, and this legislation will help facilitate that mission.

For these reasons, the League urges your support for House Bill 5514. We appreciate your consideration of this important measure and welcome any opportunity to further discuss its benefits to Rhode Island's municipalities.
