Dear Joseph, Sharon, and Stephen,

Please find attached the Film Office projections for film, television, documentary, and theatrical productions utilizing the motion picture tax incentive program. **IMPORTANT:** 2026 credits are capped at \$20 million. Credits are earned in the year of completion of all production activity in the state of Rhode Island. Credits are issued for the year they are earned, with a three-year rollover. Credits are based on 30% of qualified expenditures.

Six (6) productions have applied for the 2026 tax credits to date.

- Six (6) productions are currently in production, slated to complete RI production activities in 2026.
- We have currently committed a total of **\$13,588,782** in tax credits for the above productions for calendar year 2026.
