1. Article 1 – Relating to Making Appropriations in Support of FY 2026

Section 1

Page 33, After Line 16. Insert the following language: “Provided that of this amount, \$6,500,000 is appropriated to the Municipal Roads Grant Program known as RhodeRestore to provide funding to municipalities for the construction and maintenance of roads, sidewalks, and bridges.”

Page 33: Strike all language contained on Lines 29 through 31.

2. Article 3 – Relating to Government Reform and Reorganization

Section 24

The following two changes correct for an omission in not properly changing the reference from the existing Rhode Island Longitudinal Data System to the new Rhode Island Integrated Data System.

Page 103, Line 14: Strike “RILDS” and replace with “RIIDS”.

Page 103, Line 17: Strike “RILDS” and replace with “RIIDS”.

3. Article 11 – Relating to Assault Weapons

Section 1

Page 264, Line 3: Strike “(6)” and replace with “(5)” and renumber all subsequent subdivisions (from Page 264, Lines 8 through 23) accordingly.
